Wi-Fi

Free Visitor Wi-Fi is available throughout the building and no password is required. Simply select "Engine Shed- Visitor Wi-Fi" to connect.

Café

Gift shop

5. Getting Here/ Parking

Reach us easily by road or rail - our building is clearly visible from the bus and train stations.

If arriving on foot or by train or bus, the Engine Shed is a five-minute walk across Stirling Bridge (modern white bridge next to train station). Turn left as you exit the train station, or right if you arrive at the bus station. Stairs lead up to the bridge which is fully accessible, with a lift at either end, or the walkway in between.

If coming by car, parking is available at Forthside car park (£1.40 per day), see bottom right of map below. There are two accessible parking bays for blue badge holders located at the front of the Engine Shed building by the road running parallel to the train station.
